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SAFETY AND PRECAUTIONS

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The SMT-D-4P-EM is a control switch intended to generate a control signal to regulate the rotational speed of EC motors. The 10 VDC supply voltage is converted into three steps, corresponding to the relevant switch position. Two of the output voltages (switch positions 1 and 2) can be adjusted by build-in trimmers.. The enclosure of the switch is splash-proof and suitable for both surface and inset mounting.



MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS IN STEPS

Before you start mounting your SMT-D-4P-EM, read carefully "Safety and Precautions" and follow the steps:


For inset mounting

- 1. Remove the knob by turning it to the right until it pops out.
- 2. Unscrew the nut and remove the cover of the external enclosure.
- 3. Do the wiring according to the wiring diagram (see Fig. 1 Wiring and connections).



4. Mount the internal enclosure into the wall adhering to the mounting dimensions shown in **Fig. 2** *Mounting dimensions - inset mounting.*








Mount the unit so that the terminal block and connections are at the lower side.

- Adjust the position 1 and 2 output voltage trimmers using a flat screwdriver. See Fig. 4.
- **6.** Mount back the cover and secure it with the nut.
- 7. Put back the knob and turn it to position "0".
- 8. Turn on the power supply.


For surface mounting

- 1. Remove the knob by turning it to the right until it pops out.
- 2. Unscrew the nut and remove the cover of the external enclosure.
- 3. Mount the external enclosure onto the surface by means of screws and dowels (not included in the set) adhering to the mounting dimensions shown in Fig. 3 Mounting dimensions - surface mounting.





- 4. Insert the cables through the grommets..
- Insert the internal enclosure into the external one and fix it using the screws and washers included in the set.
- 6. Do the wiring according to the wiring diagram (see Fig. 1 Wiring and connections)
- Adjust the position 1 and 2 output voltage trimmers using a flat screwdriver. See
 Fig. 4.





Mount the unit so that the terminal block and connections are at the lower side.

- 8. Mount back the cover and secure it with the nut.
- 9. Put back the knob and turn it to position "0".
- 10. Turn on the power supply.

VERIFICATION OF INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS
